1- Do not become root under any circumstance.

2- Running sudo:

- Dockers → NO
- systemctl status → NO
- chown and chgrp → YES
- chmod → It depends on the permissions of your user on the file/folder/program, etc.
- system crontab → YES
- personal crontab → NO
- kill, nice and renice → It depends on the permissions of your user on the process and if you want to increase or decrease a process priority.

3- We will not solve problems with regard to:

- booting (starting) process
- software that you should have installed on your system if you had paid attention to our explanations and properly done the exercises.
- how to take screenshots, paste screenshots, open libreoffice or create PDF files
- how to share data between your physical computer and your virtual computer
- how to send your report
